Commencing 4th May 2009, 8 weeks, 10 credits



First modules are **fully funded** (course fees and learning materials) by South Central Strategic Health Authority. Subsequent module fees are also funded, but learning materials are not funded (learning materials for 20 credit modules = £135, for 10 credit modules = £105).

Modules are delivered through distance learning supported by regular on-line activities. They are suitable for those currently in a managerial role and who ideally, already hold a degree level qualification (NVQ level 4) or substantial management experience. Modules can be taken completely independently, but are part of a wider programme of courses that can lead to the award of a post-graduate qualification in management with the University of Reading.
