Dr Honor Merriman is a primary care educator in Oxfordshire for the past decade. She is CPD tutor for Oxfordshire. She is also a GP trainer in Headington where she also works as a partner in a busy practice.

Honor has developed the training of GP appraisers in Oxfordshire and sees education in primary care as the major factor in improving both patient care and clinician job satisfaction. In the past she has taught medical students and was a SIFT fellow, a local initiative to develop the teaching in the Oxford University Clinical School. She is on the executive of NAPCE and is an active member of the Faculty Board of the Thames Valley faculty of the RCGP.

From this broad background she will encourage those in the workshop to look at both CPD and pre-qualification education.
