



South Central Management Network

What is it?

The National Management Network is a joint development initiated by the Department of Health and the Institute of Healthcare Management (IHM), which is supported by NHS South Central locally.

Who is it for?

It is for managers and leaders across health and social care, primary and secondary care, voluntary and private sectors and anyone who manages in a health-related role. It is open to all managers, and so far over 620 managers have registered as participants throughout the South Central area.

It was launched in November 2006, and in response to comments that it is valuable to hold meetings locally, learning network meetings are now usually held every three months locations – in Berkshire, Buckinghamshire, Hampshire and Oxfordshire – with occasional central meetings.

What are the topics?

Recent subjects have included;

Mentoring

Change management,

The Leadership Qualities Framework,

Role transition, the first 100 days,

Career planning,

How to be a productive manager

Personal development planning

The meetings supplement email contact with participants about resources and events, and a designated website is being planned.



What is the purpose of the network?

The purpose is not only to provide network participants with access to others from a variety of healthcare backgrounds, but also to:

Provide high personal value from these connections which can often be outside of existing healthcare areas through learning events and continuing professional development (CPD)

Respond and adapt to network participants' changing healthcare management needs and behaviours

Discuss ways in which certain healthcare management issues are tackled - what went well, what went not so well and what would be repeated if done again

Keep ahead of the trends and predict future issues that give network participants a 'knowledge edge' of new ideas and initiatives.

The Management Network can be used in a wide variety of ways by managers either as a stand-alone support for individuals, or in conjunction with other learning methods and networks already provided in their own local area or organisation.

Who can join?

Anyone can join the Management Network – you just need to be managing people or resources. You don't have to be a member of the IHM - and it is **FREE!** You get access to a wide range of e-learning material as well to help you acquire the skills and knowledge you need quickly, easily and at a pace that suits you without attending classes.
